

**CALIFORNIA IN-HOME
PROTECTIVE INTERVENTIONS**

1. Direct intervention by worker
2. Use of family, neighbors, or others as safety resource
3. Use of community agencies or services as safety resources
4. Use of tribal, Indian community service agency, and/or ICWA program resources
5. Caregiver protects victim from perpetrator
6. Alleged perpetrator leaves household
7. Non-offending caregiver moves to safe environment with child
8. Legal action planned or initiated—child remains in home
9. Other (specify)

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
